# BUSINESS & EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP ● BHS/PV HIGH SCHOOL CAREER ACADEMIES

## ALLIED HEALTH



This course meets daily at Scott Community College on the Belmont Campus. Students explore different types of careers through a

combination of lecture, lab experiences, and clinical rotations at Scott. Areas of exploration include: Nursing, Surgical Technology, Health Information Management, Cancer Information Management, Dental Assisting/ Dental Hygiene, Radiologic Technologies, Sonography (ultrasound), Electroneurodiagnostics (END).

**Fall Semester** Time: 8-9:30 am  
Location: SCC Belmont Campus



## BUSINESS ENTREPRENEURSHIP

This course blends entrepreneurship and business skills necessary to operate a small business. Through observation and practical experiences at various QC businesses, students will learn the basics of social responsibility, management, production, human resources, marketing and finance.

**Spring Semester** Time: 1:45-3:15 pm  
Location: SCC Belmont Campus/QCA Businesses



## EDUCATION

This course provides 16 weeks of studying educational topics and understand the role of a teacher in the classroom. Students will have the opportunity to spend 8 weeks in two separate classroom settings.

## ENGINEERING

This course helps students to understand the field of engineering through lectures and hands on projects. The fundamentals of engineering are covered in lectures at Scott Community College and through on-site visits to John Deere manufacturing and design plants. At the plants the engineering staff explains real life projects and the approaches used by engineers to solve those problems. Students are divided into teams and given an opportunity to present their ideas for solutions.

## LOGISTICS

The course will provide an overview of the role of logistics in today's business world, terminology in the field of logistics and an overview of the major functional areas of the logistics field such as the supply chain, transportation, inventory management, procurement, distribution and warehousing, regulatory and compliance, information technology, finance, and organizational management. Students will practice skills at the Sivyer Steele and other businesses throughout the QCA.

## TRANSPORTATION TECHNOLOGIES

This course is designed to prepare students to enter the world of automotive repair. The course will be divided into the following units: basic core skills, diesel power equipment, automotive technology, and collision repair.
